ADMISSION PROCESS

- » Online Application
- » CHF 1'000 Deposit (non-refundable). Payable within two weeks of application to reserve place
- » Remaining fee to be paid within 8 weeks of receiving the invoice
- » Submit colour, passport photo via email
- » Submit travel form once travel arrangements are confirmed



CANCELLATIONS

In the event of a cancellation, the deposit is non-refundable. With respect to any fees which have already been paid in full, a refund of the balance will be considered only in the event that the cancellation is communicated to us in writing no later than one month prior to the commencement date of the course. Any cancellations made after this date will not receive a refund. No refund will be made in respect of any child leaving before the end of the course.

INCLUDED IN FEES

- » Full board and accommodation,

AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES

Students rotate through a varied activity plan within a group of students the same age. They are assigned a group leader (staff member) that accompanies them to all activities. Afternoon activities take place from 14h00 - 17h00 and may include: art, camp craft, team games, yoga, drama, raft-building, orienteering, hiking, swimming, bowling, climbing (indoor and outdoor), horse riding, golf (crazy golf and driving range), cookery, face painting, ice skating, river rafting, canyoning (older students), bridge swing (younger students), water park, tennis, sailing, stand up paddle board, windsurfing, banana boat.

BOARDING LIFE

Students are allocated their boarding house based on gender, age and to include a diverse range of nationalities. Each boarding house has a live-in house team (house parent and two tutors) who manage the well-being of every student and are the first point of contact for parents. Rooms are spacious and are shared with two or three other students of a similar age.

MOBILE PHONE USE

We encourage students to make the most of their summer school opportunity and to be fully involved in the life of the community. To encourage this phone use is restricted to between 17h00 and 18h30 each day when they can call home. During the 2 day expedition, students will not have their phone.
